Summary Care Record

As part of the NHS computerisation program our practice is shortly to be involved in uploading information to the NHS computer system operated by the Department of Health. This is called the Summary Care Record.

We are currently preparing to send information about the medicines you are being prescribed and any drug allergies or sensitivities you may have. The Department of Health have assumed that you are happy for this to happen unless you specifically tell your doctor in writing that you do not agree to this.
